- The <u>Condition</u> of Humanity <u>without</u> Christ (1-3)
  - The central human problem is that we are <u>dead</u> in our <u>trespasses</u> and <u>sins</u>. (v. 1)
  - "Trespasses" are acts of <u>commission</u>, "sins" refers to <u>omissions</u>.
  - Verses 1-3 paint a picture of what our life was like <u>before</u> Christ. (v. 2)
  - There are <u>demonic</u> forces at work, and there are <u>eternal</u> consequences at stake.
  - Like Romans 2 & 3, Paul includes <u>Jews</u> along with <u>Gentiles</u> in his indictment of humanity.
     (v. 3)
- The <u>Contrast</u> of Grace <u>through</u> Christ (4-7)
  - We were dead in our sins, <u>BUT GOD</u>!!! (v. 4)
  - What did God do? He <u>saved</u> us! (v. 5)
    - 4. God made us <u>alive</u> together with Christ. (v. 5)
    - 5. God has <u>raised</u> us with Christ. (v. 6)
    - 6. God has seated us with Christ. (v. 6)
- The <u>Consequence</u> of Grace in Christ (8-10)
  - Salvation is by God's <u>grace</u>. It is His <u>gift</u> to us. (v. 8)
  - <u>Salvation</u> is not exactly the same things as justification.
  - Justification is how we become part of God's <u>family</u>, salvation is how we are rescued from <u>disaster</u>.
    - We are saved by *grace* through *faith*.
  - We are God's workmanship, His (Greek: poiema), poem.
  - Salvation is not a matter of family <u>heritage</u>, it is a matter of new <u>creation</u>.
  - God wants to make you His unbroken <u>masterpiece</u> of new creation as His free gift through faith in His Son to love and serve the world.
