 - The mystery of Christ is that now we, the Gentiles, are <u>heirs</u> together-with, members of the <u>body</u> together-with, and partakers of God's <u>promise</u> together-with Christ-believing lews.
 - But do we really <u>want</u> this revealed mystery playing out in and changing our individual lives and how we do church?
 - The challenge is for us to see the gospel for what the <u>Bible</u> says it is, not for what we want it to be.
- The Obligations of the Ministry of Christ
 - o Paul was given both a <u>revelation</u> and a <u>responsibility</u>.
 - o Along with the <u>revelation</u> comes the <u>obligations</u>.
 - o 1st Obligation: To declare the good news to the world.
 - The <u>darker</u> your past, the more glorious God's <u>grace</u> can shine in your life.
 - Paul combined personal humility with apostolic authority.
 - This revelation imposes on <u>every</u> Christian the same obligation to share the gospel.
 - 2nd Obligation: To <u>display</u> the good news to the world.
 - The manifold wisdom of God is displayed to the world *through the* <u>church!</u>
 - The very existence of this multi-<u>national</u>, multi-<u>cultural</u>, multi-<u>ethnic</u>, world-wide family is the declaration to the dark powers that their time is up.
 - Stott: If the church is central to God's <u>purpose</u>, it must be central to our <u>lives</u>.
 - Personal Question: How can <u>I</u> better display God's manifold wisdom through <u>my</u> commitment to His church?
